Republican Ballot Propositions

(Propuestas para la Boleta del Partido Republicano)

Proposition 1 — No

Texas should replace the property tax system with an appropriate consumption tax equivalent.

(Propuesta 1) — (No)

(Texas debería reemplazar el sistema de impuestos a la propiedad con un sistema similar basado en el impuesto al consumo.)

Proposition 2 — Yes

No governmental entity should ever construct or fund construction of toll roads without voter approval.

(Propuesta 2) — (Sí)

(Ninguna entidad gubernamental debería construir o financiar la construcción de carreteras de pago sin la aprobación de los votantes.)

Proposition 3 — Yes

Republicans in the Texas House should select their Speaker nominee by secret ballot in a binding caucus without Democrat influence.

(Propuesta 3) — (Sí)

(Los republicanos en la Cámara de Representantes de Texas deben seleccionar a su candidato a Presidente de la Cámara por votación secreta en una asamblea vinculante sin la influencia del partido Demócrata.)

Proposition 4 — Yes

Texas should require employers to screen new hires through the free E-Verify system to protect jobs for legal workers.

(Propuesta 4) — (Sí)

(Texas debe exigir a los empleadores que filtren a sus nuevos empleados a través del sistema gratuito E-Verify para proteger los empleos de los trabajadores legales.)

Proposition 5 — Yes

Texas families should be empowered to choose from public, private, charter, or homeschool options for their children's education, using tax credits or exemptions without government constraints or intrusion.

(Propuesta 5) — (Sí)

(Las familias de Texas deben tener la facultad de elegir entre opciones públicas, privadas, escuelas chárter o de educación en el hogar para la educación de sus hijos, utilizando créditos fiscales o exenciones sin restricciones o intrusiones gubernamentales.)

Proposition 6 — Yes

Texas should protect the privacy and safety of women and children in spaces such as bathrooms, locker rooms, and showers in all Texas schools and government buildings.

(Propuesta 6) — (Sí)

(Texas debería proteger la privacidad y la seguridad de las mujeres y los niños en espacios tales como baños, vestuarios y duchas en todas las escuelas y edificios gubernamentales de Texas.)

Proposition 7 — Yes

I believe abortion should be abolished in Texas.

(Propuesta 7) — (Sí)

(Yo creo que el aborto debería ser abolido en Texas.)

Proposition 8 — Yes

Voter fraud should be a felony in Texas to help ensure fair elections.

(Propuesta 8) — (Sí)

(El fraude electoral debería ser un delito de Felonía en Texas para así ayudar a asegurar elecciones justas.)

Proposition 9 — Yes

Texas demands that Congress completely repeal Obamacare.

(Propuesta 9) — (Sí)

(Texas exige que el Congreso derogue por completo Obamacare.)

Proposition 10 — Yes

To slow the growth of property taxes, yearly revenue increases should be capped at 4%, with increases in excess of 4% requiring voter approval.

(Propuesta 10) — (Sí)

(Para frenar el crecimiento de los impuestos a la propiedad, los aumentos anuales de los ingresos deben limitarse al 4% y se deberá requerir la aprobación de los votantes para aumentos superiores al 4%.)

Proposition 11

Tax dollars should not be used to fund the building of stadiums for professional or semi-professional sports teams.

(Propuesta 11)

(Los dólares de los impuestos no se deben usar para financiar la construcción de estadios para equipos deportivos profesionales o semi-profesionales.)

NOTES:

1. We looked for candidates who meet the qualifications in Exodus 18:21. They are people of good character and are able (competent) to serve in the office for which they seek election.
2. We sent each candidate a survey giving opportunity to share their religious values.
3. In the absence of a complete survey, we googled the candidate or secured whatever information we could.
4. We deliberated thoughtfully before giving our endorsement. We attended candidate forums, talked to some candidates by phone and consulted with other groups in the state who were vetting.
5. We believe our list will be beneficial to the citizen who is seeking to evaluate who to vote for.
